Educator cards are a way for area teachers to check out items for classroom use without having to use their personal library card.

To be eligible for a card, you must be employed in a licensed school in the 61571 zip code: preschool, public school, or private school. If it is not located in that zip code, please get in touch with your nearest library to ask about getting a card. Library cards from any area libraries can be used at WDL.
